1. Documents for submission

Paper (PDF, included in symposium proceedings) A4, double column, maximum 10MB, and maximum 10 pages.

Instruction for making pdf files is as follows. Compose manuscripts including figures and tables by using Word or TeX. Convert the manuscript to a pdf file. Include all the fonts in the pdf file. Make sure that the printed size is A4. Before submission, make sure that there is no typo with multiple PCs.

2. Format

A4 pages should have 20 mm for the top and bottom margins, and 15 mm for the left and right margins. Use 9-point fonts for the text. The text should be in two-column format, except for the title, the authors, and the abstract.

3. Manuscript

- Header: Do not change the header.
- Title: Use 14-point fonts of Arial, Helvetica, or cm (bold) font faces. The title should be centered. The first letters of the main words should be capitalized.
- Authors: Use 10-point fonts of Times, Times New Roman or cm font faces. The authors are followed by their affiliation, postal address, and E-mail address (if possible).
- Abstract: Necessary only for a paper. Use 9-point fonts of Times, Times New Roman or cm font faces. Leave 1 line between the authors and the abstract. The abstract should be written in 100 to 150 words. The width of the abstract is 150 mm.
- Text: Leave 1 line between the abstract and the text.
- Figures and tables: Put clear figures at appropriate positions in the manuscript.
- References: Cite the bibliography like this (1) and put it after the main text.

4. Offprint

No offprint. The papers will be downloaded by participants from the symposium website.

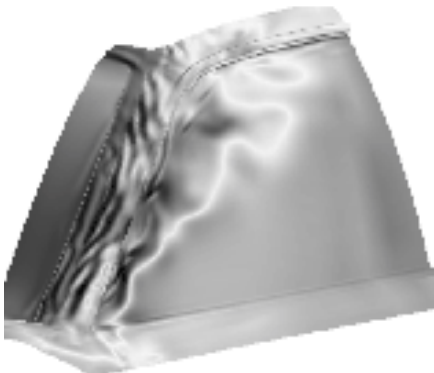


Fig. 1: Sample figure.
